



Bioscience Entry Course (Undergraduate)

Human Biology & Chemistry

Physiology and biochemistry underpin the science of nutritional therapy and nutritional science. Successfully completing our home-study entry courses in Human Biology and Chemistry meets the academic requirements for entry on to the BSc (Hons) Nutritional Science degree validated by Middlesex University, and the CNELM Dietary Educator for students without 'A' levels or equivalent qualifications in these subjects. Many students successfully complete our entry courses every year prior to entrance.

Course Overview

Our undergraduate Bioscience Entry Course (BEC) includes modules in Human Biology and Chemistry and are set at a level which assumes no prior knowledge of the subjects and gradually takes you through the concepts (including 'A' level concepts) that are important for you to understand; in order to join the BSc (Hons) Nutritional Science degree course that we teach at CNELM. This degree course is validated by Middlesex University. Both modules are entirely home-study with tutor support. It may be possible to take our BEC modules as entrance to other health sciences courses. Applicants should check that the content of our courses meets the requirement with the training provider.

Both Human Biology and Chemistry modules **MUST** be completed prior to enrolling on the degree programme. In exceptional circumstance it may be possible to combine completion of the Bioscience Entry Course with the start of the degree programme with modules that are not dependent on these underpinning subjects. NB: Continued registration on the degree programme would remain subject to completing the Bioscience Entry Course at the accepted level.

CNELM can also offer an additional Maths module with assessment to support students without GCSE or equivalent qualifications. Contact info@cnelm.ac.uk for further details, including course costs.

Course Length & Study Options

- Human Biology and Chemistry are taken online with tutor support. Both modules are coursework assessed.
- Students are advised to allow approximately 120 hours of study for each module. There are 4 entry windows to the BEC over the year in Jan/Feb, Apr/May, Jul/Aug and Oct/Nov
- Human Biology and Chemistry modules ideally should be completed prior to enrolling on the degree programme, however some modules on the degree course can be started while completing BEC modules as they are not dependent on biology and chemistry.

NB: BEC modules must be passed in order to continue to progress with the degree programme.

Chemistry	£800	Payable in full prior to enrolment on the modules, or over three consecutive months with a first payment of £300 prior to enrolment on the module and two further payments of £250. A 5% discount is applied if paid for in full prior to enrolment - Fee £760
Combined Human Biology & Chemistry	£1,600	If both modules are purchased at the same time, applicants can benefit from a 10% discount on the total cost - £1,440
