



Bioscience Entry Course

The full Bioscience Entry Course (BEC) is designed for students wishing to join the MSc or Postgraduate Diploma (PG Dip) in Personalised Nutrition who have not previously studied **Chemistry, Human Biology, Biochemistry and Physiology**. Individual modules are recommended to applicants based on their unique background. Bioscience underpins nutritional science and completing the BEC or specified modules is aimed to prepare students for studying nutrition at postgraduate level. Some applicants are recommended a refresher if it is 5 or more years since studying these subjects or have used their knowledge at work.

Students can apply to take these modules for entry to other courses.

Course Overview

- Human Biology Level 3 (L3)
- Chemistry Level 3 (L3)

Each module is completed independently with tutor support available via email and online video call. Students study in their own time to review pre-recorded webinars and associated online resources. Assessments include quizzes, short answer questions and essays. Each module should take 120 hours each to complete. Allow 450-500 hours total for 4 modules. Students pace themselves in order to meet a January, April or September intake for the MSc or PGDip. The modules provide a robust underpinning for nutrition and health sciences.

Depending on the prior background some applicants will be required to take other modules to Bridge to start the MSc or PGDip programmes including, but not limited to, CNELM's undergraduate **Research Methods** and a short **Research Project**. Level 5 Research Methods **£450**. Level 6 Research Project **£700**.
